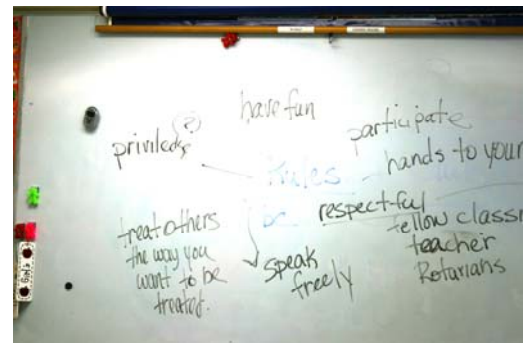
The meeting began with the Rotarians introducing themselves to the Students and the students introducing themselves to the visiting Rotarians.
