- John Townsend reported the **Millenium Early Act** will sell water at the Health Fair on April 6.



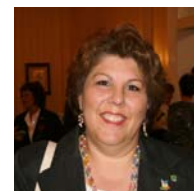
- Pam Hollich said the **Brookwood Early Act** will be selling cookies as a fundraiser.
