Geoff Slawson donated his tickets for Glenn Miller to the club. These tickets were then auctioned. Thank you, Geoff!



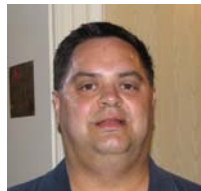
There is a **Rotary Board meeting** next Wednesday.
