President Steve. called the meeting to order on this Veteran's Day at 12:15 P.M and welcomed DG Jim and our visitors and guests



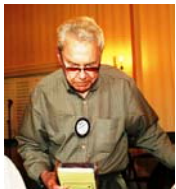
MEETING .
