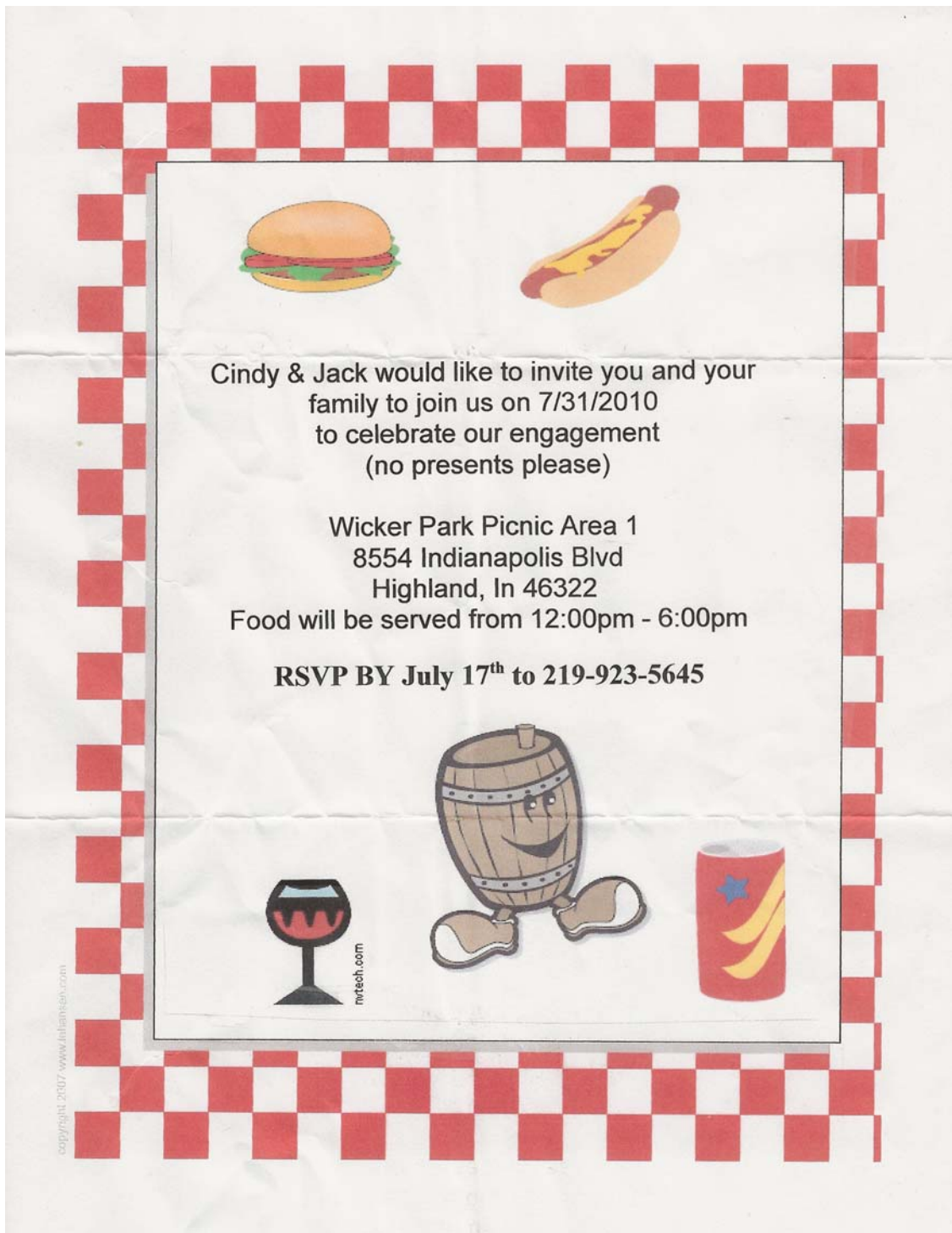
**PUN OF THE WEEK**
