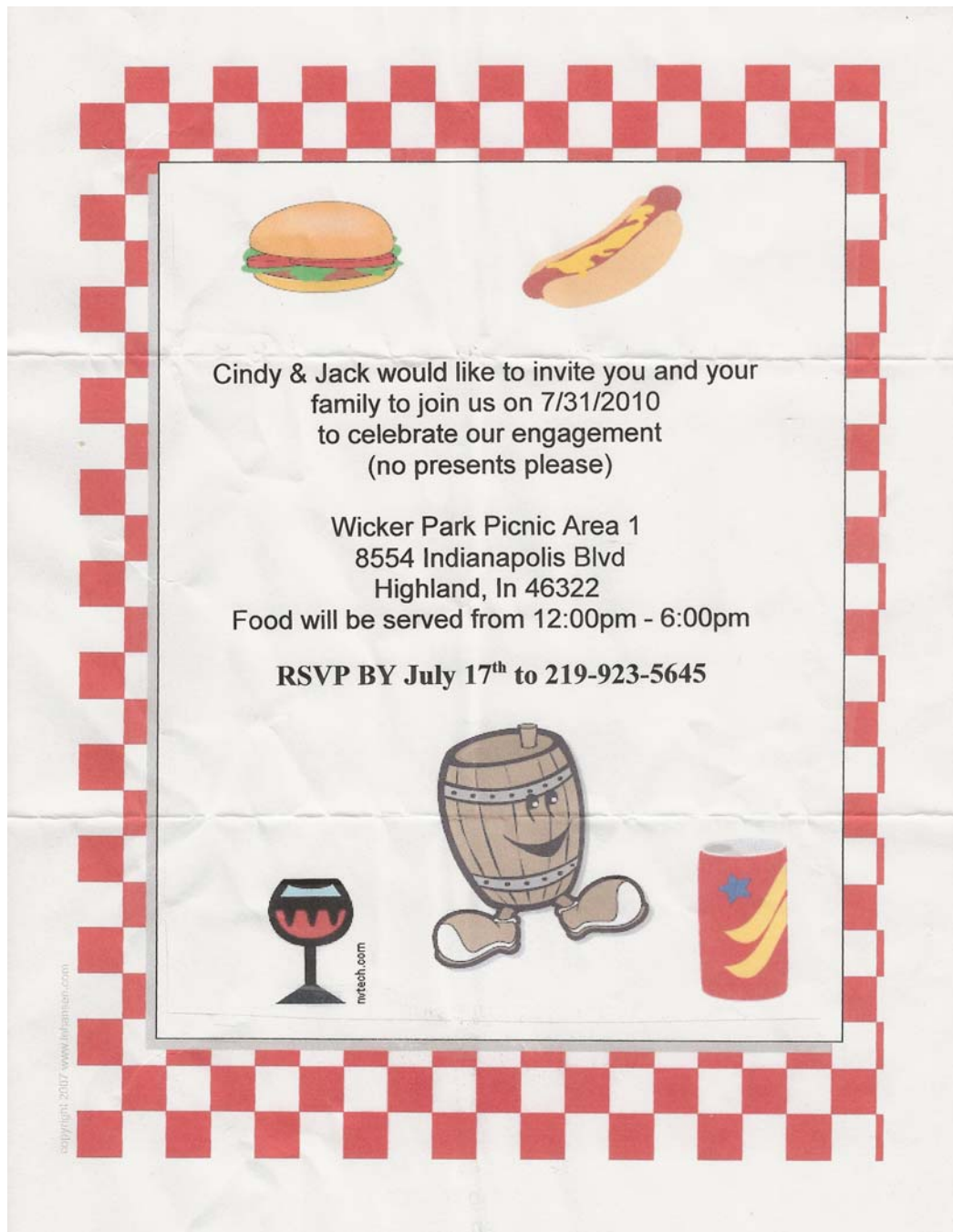


PUN OF THE WEEK
